

NOOK COLOR **SET UP AND** **DOWNLOAD GUIDE**

Congratulations on purchasing the Nook Color! This e-reader is your window to a wonderful new world of e-books!

Set up

Before you can begin to download books from the Library Website you must install the Adobe digital Edition onto your computer. You will do this only once. Here is how you do that.

1. Go to <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions>.
2. Scroll down to a big button that says INSTALL and click on that button
3. Click Install again
4. Click yes
5. Click Next
6. Click Install
7. When it shows completed click close
8. Click I agree
9. X out.
10. Click the big button that says LAUNCH
11. The Set Up Assistant will appear
12. Click continue
13. Click on "Get an Adobe ID online."
14. Minimize the set up assistant (hit the – button on top of your page)
15. Click on Create an Adobe Account
16. Fill out the form.
17. Click continue
18. Click continue
19. Maximize the Adobe Digital Editions page
20. Enter your newly created ID and Password
21. Click Activate
22. X out.

Now you are ready to download your first e-book! Enjoy your Nook and good reading!

HOW TO DOWNLOAD FREE EBOOKS FROM ISLAND PARK LIBRARY'S WEBSITE

1. Go to <http://www.islandparklibrary.org> and click on the **Nassau Digital Doorway** (download audio and e-books icon).
2. If you do not know the library's website address go to <http://nassau.lib.overdrive.com>
3. When you see the Nassau Digital Doorway catalog, you can search for a book by entering the title or author. You can also search by clicking "Complete list of new e-books". You can then arrange the books by "date added to the site". This way the new books come up first.
4. Type in the name of the book in the "search for" box or click on the title of the book. Select the "EPUB" edition.
5. If the book is not available, click Place Request and continue looking for another ebook.
6. If the book is available, click "add to the cart".
7. Proceed to checkout
8. Confirm checkout
9. Download
10. Choose Open
11. Adobe Digital Edition opens
12. You may be asked to authorize the Nook the first time you connect it to your computer when Adobe Digital Editions is open.
13. Plug your Nook into the computer using the USB cable.
14. You should see "Media" listed
15. You should see your book on the right side of the page
16. Click on the book and drag it to "Media". Wait until the copying is complete.
17. Disconnect your Nook.
18. E-books that are transferred to your Nook in this way will be located in the Library.
19. Click on My files
20. Click on Adobe Editions
21. Click on your book to open it.

To disconnect your NOOK from your personal computer:

- Ensure that no USB operations are still in progress.
- Use the procedure that is appropriate for your computer to eject or unmount the NOOK.
 - On a **PC running Microsoft Windows**, click Start>Computer, right-click the NOOK drive and choose Eject.
 - If you have a supplemental microSD card, also eject that drive.
 - Choosing Safely Remove from the right-click menu or Safely Remove Hardware from the taskbar does not work. You must **eject** the drives.
 - On a **Mac**, Ctrl-Click the icon for each drive and choose Eject.
 - On a computer running Linux, right-click the icon for each drive and choose Unmount.

At this point you can use your NOOK for reading. We recommend that you do not shop or download content while USB charging.
